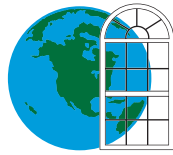

## American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 - Manufacturer's Certification Letter

This manufacturer's certification statement provides the documentation needed to receive an energy tax credit for exterior windows as defined by the "American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009". Save a copy of this document, the NFRC labels on the window(s) and the purchase receipt in your tax file. They will serve as proof to the IRS that the exterior window(s) you purchased qualified for the 2009/2010 Energy Tax Credit. The NFRC label(s) that came with your exterior window(s) can be substituted for the manufacturer's certification statement provided the window(s) meets the requirements of the "American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009" in which the U-Factor is 0.30 or less and the Solar Heat Gain Coefficient is 0.30 or less. The tax credit is for 30% of the window cost with a maximum credit of \$1500 total for 2009/2010. Windows that do not meet both of these standards are not eligible for the Energy Tax Credit. Windows must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2009, and December 31, 2010, to receive the tax credit.

The following Earthwise windows manufactured by Tri-State Wholesale Building Supplies, Inc. have been NFRC Certified to meet the requirements for the "American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009" 2009/2010 Energy Tax Credit. Tri-State cannot be held responsible for any consequences due to a sale on a non-qualifying product. The following list the products and necessary features that meet the requirements for the federal tax credit. We are certifying only these products and the associated features as qualifying products. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to ensure that they are purchasing a qualifying product. We suggest that the homeowner consult their tax advisors on all requirements regarding the federal tax credit and their qualification.
